

## **Codes of Behaviour on Erasmus+ projects**

For the safety and happiness of all the participants at our project, we would like to ask you to please respect and follow the following Codes of Behaviour.

1. Every participant has to be respected, cared for and included in the project. It is important that we care for everyone, speak nicely to each other, as well as help and cooperate with each other in a respectful way. We have no tolerance for bullying, and the person(s) will be sent home/removed right away.
  - Be friendly to others and others will be friendly upon you!
2. Participation in the activities and rendering services are required.
3. For your own safety, when leaving the premises of the meeting or the bigger group, at least three persons should always be together.
4. Please be quiet in and around the temple premises, as well as at the accommodation facilities after 10.00 PM.
5. Please do not use mobile phones during the activities, and in the temple room. Best to handle calls, text messages, etc. in the morning or evening.
6. Participants must follow vegetarian diet and the four regulative principles on the whole duration of the trip.
7. That is all right if you fall in love, but please do handle it in a proper way, according to Vaishnava etiquette. Please remember the sanctity of the temple. No flirting, embracing, or kissing during the program. If you are under 18, parents must be notified about the relationship.
8. We recommend devotional attire in and around the temple: saree, anarkali or long skirts for girls, and dhoti, pants or at least knee-length shorts for boys.
9. Kitchen services must be performed according to temple rules and regulations.
10. Please wash hands and mouth after using the toilets, before and after eating, and before doing any kitchen service.

Remember, your youth leaders are here to guide you, take care of you, and give advice when needed. They are happy to help in any way they can.
